HEALTH AND SANITATION INSPECTION REPORT

Institution: The Heritage School, Rampurhat

Upon inspection of the school premises and review of the available facilities, the following observations were made:

1. The school was established in the year 2008 and currently has approximately 1,100 students from Nursery to Class XII.
2. The institution is staffed by 56 teaching faculty members and 33 support staff.
3. A hostel facility is available with an accommodation capacity of 50 students.
4. The school consists of a four-storied building with a total of 38 classrooms.
5. Sanitary facilities comprise:
 - o 23 toilets for boys
 - o 20 toilets for girls
 - o 2 disability-friendly toilets
6. Adequate safe drinking water facilities are available on each floor of the building.
7. A total of 14 scavenging/sanitation personnel are engaged for regular cleaning and maintenance of cleanliness within the campus.
8. One canteen is operational within the school premises. However, it was observed that the canteen does not possess a valid FSSAI registration/license, which should be obtained at the earliest.
9. Handwashing facilities and necessary logistics for maintaining personal hygiene are available and functional.
10. First-aid facilities are available and are supervised by one Staff Nurse.
11. To promote menstrual hygiene management among girl students, two sanitary pad vending machines have been installed and are operational.
12. The overall cleanliness and sanitation status of the school campus, including classrooms, toilets, hostel areas, and other activity zones, was found to be satisfactory.
13. Regular awareness programmes on hygiene, sanitation, waste management, and Swachhta Abhiyan activities are conducted. Adequate arrangements for general waste management are in place.

Conclusion:

Based on the observations made during the inspection, the health, hygiene, sanitation, drinking water, and waste management facilities of The Heritage School, Rampurhat are found to be generally satisfactory and adequate for the students and staff. The institution is maintaining acceptable standards of cleanliness and sanitation. The management is advised to obtain the required FSSAI registration/license for the canteen and continue regular monitoring of hygiene and sanitation practices.
